Efforts include:

- Two community visioning meetings in April 1999
- Invited Initiative Foundation staff to seek assistance on development of a Community Fund—which turned into focus on planning for a library, and from which a library task force was created
- Continued focus on inviting the Minnesota Design Team to Wyoming

### **Vision/Purpose Statement:**

Develop a comprehensive plan to meet the needs of the growing community.

### **Priorities:**

- Visit from the Minnesota Design Team
- Planning/fundraising for a library
- Receiving completed comprehensive plan (not completed as of this writing)
- Seeking funds from the Board of Innovation and Cooperation

### **Follow Up Grants and Loans:**

- \$5,000- Grant from NSP in June 1999 to assist with covering costs of developing printed comprehensive plan documents
- \$4,200- Grant from the Initiative Foundation for Library planning
- \$10,000- Award to Wyoming Township for the Comfort Lake Diagnostic Study which assess knowledge of watershed residents on issues that affect lake areas and increase sampling site where water converges from neighboring communities

### **Key Accomplishments:**

- Two community visioning meetings in April 1999
- Invited Initiative Foundation staff to seek assistance on development of a Community Fund—which turned into focus on planning for a library, and from which a library task force was created
- Continued focus on inviting the Minnesota Design Team to Wyoming
- Completed a draft Comprehensive Plan and presented to the community in spring 2000
- Completed final Comprehensive Plan December 2000
- New library under construction, October 2004
