# Todd County Statistical Data

## DEMOGRAPHICS

Todd County has seen a **POPULATION INCREASE** of 2.8% between 1990 and 2007 adding 666 people for a 2007 population of 24,029. The population is projected to grow another 6.6% by 2010.

- The county has an **older than average population** with 23.3% being under 18 and 16.1% being 65 or older.
- 5.3% of the population is **ethnically diverse**, compared to an average of 5.7% for the region.
- As of 2000, only 10% of the population had a **Bachelor's degree or higher** which is below average for the region (15%) and much lower than the state average (27.4%).
- **Mean travel time** to work was 23.2 minutes which is below average in our region (25.9 average mean) and slightly higher than the state mean of 21.9.
- In 2004, **median household income** was \$35,369 which is significantly lower than the state median income (\$51,202) and the IF regional average (\$46,682).
- The 2004 **poverty rate** was higher than average in the region at 10.8% compared to the IF regional average of 8.4% and the state average of 8.1%.

The annual **UNEMPLOYMENT RATE** was 5.2% in 2006 and 6.7% in 2008, compared to the IF region at 7.6% and the state average of 6.8%.

From 2002 to 2007 the number of **FARMS** had increased by 4.7% as the amount of total acreage had also increased by 2.3%. The value of production had also increased by 54.7% compared to 43.4% in the IF region and a 53.7% increase statewide.
